

**First Reading, from the first letter of Saint John (1 John 1:5-2:2)**

This is what we have heard from Jesus Christ, and the message that we are announcing to  
you: God is light; there is no darkness in him at all.

If we say that we are in union with God while we are living in darkness,  
we are lying because we are not living the truth.

But if we live our lives in the light, as he is in the light,  
we are in union with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son,  
purifies us from all sin.


