Gospel, according to John (6:5-15)

Philip answered, "We would all have to work a month to buy enough bread for each person here to have only a little piece!"

Jesus said, "Tell everyone to sit down." This was a place with a lot of grass, and about 5000 people sat down there. Jesus took the loaves of bread and gave thanks for them. Then he gave them to the people who were waiting to eat. He did the same with the fish. He gave them as much as they wanted.

They all had plenty to eat. When they finished, Jesus said to his followers, "Gather the pieces of fish and bread that were not eaten. Don't waste anything." So they gathered up the pieces that were left. The people had started eating with only five loaves of barley bread. But the followers filled twelve large baskets with the pieces of food that were left. The people saw this miraculous sign that Jesus did and said, "He must be the Prophet who is coming into the world."

Jesus knew that the people planned to come get him and make him their king. So he left and went into the hills alone.
